
GRADES 1 - 6 dropoff and pickup at AWR

must be shared with ALL caregivers transporting your children





MORNING DROP OFF - Front Circle (off of Jones Drive)

- Opens 8:15 am
- Adhere to "every other car rule" when entering from Jones Drive
- There is NO PARKING in circle
- PULL UP as far forward towards Jones Drive as you can (to the "Drop Off Starts Here" sign) or to the car in front of you to allow for more cars to drop off simultaneously (at least 10 cars!)
- DO NOT STOP HALFWAY near front door as this incurs unnecessary delays for cars behind you (it only allows for 3 5 cars at a time half the cars in line are now waiting an additional minute!)
- Children MUST EXIT ON RIGHT, onto sidewalk. Please make it easy by moving younger children's car seats behind the driver
- If children cannot reliably exit car on own, do not use drop off. Park & Walk (see AWR website)
- DO NOT PASS cars on the left in circle. Wait until cars in front of you are moving
- Left turn when exiting onto Jones Drive is permissible; consider turning right to ease congestion
- Let left-turning cars OUT OF CIRCLE to keep traffic moving (if they can't depart, you can't get in)

NORTH COURT AREA (playground near playing fields)

- CLOSED FOR MORNING DROP OFF and AFTERNOON PICKUP
- Open for specific school events determined by administration. Look for dates in PTA emails

AFTERNOON PICK UP

- FRONT CIRCLE CLOSED from 2:30 3:30 to non-bus traffic
- Additional parking on Jones, Crane, Colonial, Hawthorne, Cameron, Commerce & Spring

ALL DAY

- Do not abandon vehicles, even for a minute, in front circle; it is a FIRE ZONE
- If you park on Colonial Way, use the crosswalks/crossing guards at either end of Jones Drive
- Turn the Key; Be Idle Free by law, standing vehicles can only idle 3 minutes
- FINABLE OFFENSES: Double Parking, Jaywalking, Cell Phone usage while driving. IT'S THE LAW
